Nontraditional Student Scholarship Application for Spring Semester 2026

Applicant requirements:

- Must be a resident of Cascade County, or student attending a Cascade County College
- Must be a nontraditional student, i.e. someone whose formal education has been interrupted, whether before or after finishing high school.
- Must be enrolled in a program leading to an Associate Degree, Certificate or equivalent.
- Must have earned 24 credits by the end of this fall semester.
- Must be attending a college or university accredited by the Northwest Association of Schools and Colleges or another Association recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation.

Application requirements:

- Submit a fully completed application including a copy of your Student Aid Index and other awards received.
- Submit a current college transcript, official or unofficial.
- Submit 2 letters of reference, either faculty or employer.

Selection of applicants:

The Associate Degree Scholarship Committee will prioritize the selection of applicants based on these criteria:

- Financial need, including SAI rating
- Scholastic achievement
- Personal narrative
- References

The scholarship money will be awarded directly to the school in the student's name.

Applicants will be notified of results before Thanksgiving.
